The flowers shown below flower mainly in autumn.



**Botanical Name:** *Epacris impressa*  
**Common Name:** Common heath  
**Flowering Time:** Autumn, winter  
**Height:** Erect shrub to waist high  
**Occurrence:** Very common



**Botanical Name:** *Calostemma purpureum*  
**Common Name:** Garland lily  
**Flowering Time:** Late summer, early autumn  
**Height:** Shin to knee high  
**Occurrence:** Very common



**Botanical Name:** *Corunastylis* sp. Adelaide Hills  
**Common Name:** Common midge orchid  
**Flowering Time:** Autumn  
**Height:** Less than 10cm.  
**Occurrence:** Common



**Botanical Name:** *Eriochilus* aff. *Cucullatus*  
*'Hills Woodland'*  
**Common Name:** Parson's bands orchid  
**Flowering Time:** Autumn  
**Height:** To 20cm.  
**Occurrence:** Very common



**Botanical Name:** *Astroloma humifusum*  
**Common Name:** Native cranberry  
**Flowering Time:** Most of the year  
**Height:** Ground hugging mat  
**Occurrence:** Very common
