Evening bushcare is back!

Come any time between 5pm to 7pm

Every second Tuesday

Starting 15th November until end of March

The evening bushcare has a flexible start and finish time, so if you can't get there until 6, then come at 6! If you need to leave early, leave early!

Where: We will meet at an easily accessible location, usually outside of the park (but *not the Green Shed*) and walk into the weeding area. We will work at sites that are close to carparks and tracks, so we're easy to find, and I will put some signs out to help show where we are. The start location will be publicised before each session on Friends of Belair NP facebook page and via email/SMS.

What to bring: Please bring your own gloves and tools if you have them or talk to me about what you need and I can supply. The sessions will probably be a little warmer than the usual morning ones so **bring water**.

If you're new to bushcare and don't know how it works that's fine, I can help you find some easily identified weeds and show you how we remove them without causing damage to the native plants we are trying to protect.

Cancellations: sessions will be cancelled if there is:

- A **Total Fire Ban** or
- a **Severe Weather Warning** for the Mt. Lofty Ranges, or
- if the forecast temperature for the day is **34 degrees** or higher, or
- if there is **heavy rain**.

You will need to check the conditions / forecast. I will not be contacting everyone for cancellations.

All the other usual bushcare requirements apply, including needing to become a member after three sessions, but also the benefits of receiving a Parks Pass.
