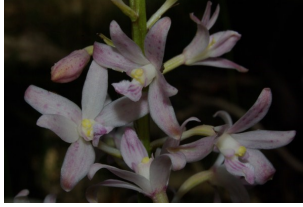


FRIENDS OF BELAIR NATIONAL PARK

Botanical Name: *Dipodium roseum*
Common Name: Hyacinth orchid
Flowering Time: Summer
Height: To 75cm.
Occurrence: Common



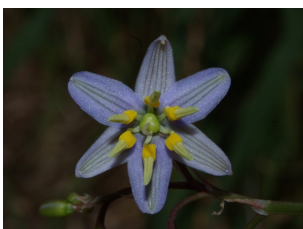
Botanical Name: *Orthoceras strictum*
Common Name: Horned orchid
Flowering Time: Late spring to early summer
Height: 20-45cm.
Occurrence: Rare



Botanical Name: *Brunonia australis*
Common Name: Blue pincushion
Flowering Time: Late spring to early summer
Height: To shin high
Occurrence: Common



Botanical Name: *Olearia grandiflora*
Common Name: Mt Lofty daisy
Flowering Time: Spring to early summer
Height: Upright shrub to 60cms
Occurrence: Common



Botanical Name: *Dianella longifolia*
Common Name: Pale flax lily
Flowering Time: Spring to early summer
Height: To thigh high
Occurrence: Rare



Botanical Name: *Linum marginale*
Common Name: Native flax
Flowering Time: Late spring to early summer
Height: To thigh high
Occurrence: Uncommon



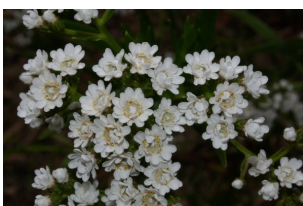
Botanical Name: *Lobelia gibbosa*
Common Name: Tall lobelia
Flowering Time: Summer
Height: To shin high
Occurrence: Uncommon



Botanical Name: *Eryngium rostratum*
Common Name: Blue devil
Flowering Time: Summer
Height: To shin high
Occurrence: Very rare



Botanical Name: *Bursaria spinosa*
Common Name: Christmas bush
Flowering Time: Summer
Height: Shrub/tree to head high
Occurrence: Very common



Botanical Name: *Ixodia achillaeoides*
Common Name: Hills daisy, fireweed
Flowering Time: Summer
Height: Shrub to 60-150 cms
Occurrence: Very common
