

FoBNP Bushcare Report for June 2019

In June the FoBNP bush carers worked a total of 165.5 hours.

- 74 hours were spent in VMU 52 where we cleared mostly Sollya and boneseed.
- 64 hours were spent in VMU 12, which is in a fairly good state and well-worth keeping that way, but we found and removed some boneseed, Watsonia, olive, Sollya and Bridal Creeper. The Third Saturday weeding group helped in this VMU, contributing 18 hours.
- Mary and Helen spent 4 hours in VMU 20 (the Dam area) taking out ash and thistles.
- On the Blackwood Kindergarten planting day we were helped with 11.5 hours contributed by Mark and Jenny Pedlar, Mike and Peggy Cerchez, Carol Parrott and the Raines.
- In addition, at the Memorial event for Eric Cole many in the group attending worked pulling boneseed and Sollya in VMU 15 (Eric and Mary's adopted block), contributing another 12 hours bushcare.
